VINTAGE: 2012

GRAPES: Semillon Sauvignon Blanc Percentage: 55% Semillon

45% Sauvignon Blanc

ORIGIN OF GRAPES: Margaret River Percentage: 100%

Western Australia (Sub region: Wilyabrup)

VINIFICATION: 100% fermented in stainless steel with selected yeasts and bottled early to promote

the 'fruit driven' nature of this wine.

ANALYSIS: Alcohol: 12.2 %

pH: 3.1

Acid: 6.2 grams/L

Sugar: 2.6 grams/L

COLOUR: Pale straw, with a green tinged hue.

NOSE: Initial lifted herbaceous characters of pea pod, grass, lemon thyme and lime, with

underlying passionfruit, blackcurrant and lychee characters. There is also a light

nutty character from a small percentage of barrel fermentation.

PALATE: Full and long with soft textured palate and balanced acidity. Smoky pea pod along

with fresh grass and thyme are balanced by passionfruit and citrus characters with

a long herbaceous finish.

WINEMAKERS This wine aims to combine the aromatics of Sauvignon Blanc with the mouth feel comments: and intensity of cool climate Semillon. Short to medium term cellaring will soften

the wine, tempering its youthful exuberance and allow for the progression to the

secondary characters of aniseed and honey.

FOOD MATCH: Many options here, including grilled scallops, sushi and sashimi, mediterranean fish

soup to a nicoise salade.

DELIVERY: Deliveries to capital cities is 48 to 72 hours. Outlying areas a bit longer.

2011 cabernet merlot

PRODUCT: The Devil Drives

VINTAGE: 2011

GRAPES: Cabernet Merlot Percentage: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon

40% Merlot 5% Petit Verdot

ORIGIN OF GRAPES: Margaret River Percentage: 100%

Western Australia (Sub region: Wilyabrup)

VINIFICATION: Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot parcels were fermented individually before maturing

in French oak for 18 months. Post blending, the wine was naturally balanced and

was left unfined though it received a light filtration before being bottled.

ANALYSIS: Alcohol: 14.5 %

pH: 3.7

Acid: 5.9 grams/L

Sugar: 0.6 grams/L

COLOUR: Bright and Medium to deep red.

NOSE: There's a brooding, briary quality to its aromatics, mixed with fresh blood plums

and fragrant red berry fruit.

PALATE: Complex and savoury with fruit flavours and undertones of black olive.

WINEMAKERS Both Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot excel in the cool maritime climate and gravelly

COMMENTS: soils of the Margaret River wine region. Cabernet Sauvignon provides the tannin and

structure whilst Merlot adds texture and mid palate 'sweetness' to the wines profile. Short to medium term cellaring will allow further integration and a more complex

offering.

FOOD MATCH: Many options here, including Spanish Roasted vegetables, medium rare porterhouse,

and most cheeses.
