**WINEMAKING NOTES:** This wine has been made as a concentrated, spicy expression of the Garnacha varietal. An average vine age of well over 45 years combined with the unique microclimate of has ensured great concentration of fruit from extremely small yields (circa 17hl/ha). Careful temperature controlled fermentation and the collaboration of New World trained winemakers and local knowledge has produced a fruit driven wine typical of the Calatayud area. Old concentrated bush vine fruit, hand harvested, crushed and destemmed. Temp controlled alcoholic fermentation to 28 degrees celsius for 7 days with pumpovers and delistage for colour and tannin extraction followed by a short maceration. Pressed off skins using only free run wine followed by full malolactic fermentation. The wine is then cold stabilised and given a fine earth filtration.

**CELLAR POTENTIAL:** Will improve in bottle for up to 18 – 24 months.

**TASTING NOTE:** Full bodied wine with fine, soft tannins and well balanced acidity. Soft raspberry and wild berry fruits give way to a long, smooth and spicy finish.

**FOOD RECOMMENDATIONS:** Tapas, barbeque foods, lamb and duck.  
Even try slightly chilled for the summer months

#### WINEMAKING NOTES:

Old concentrated bush vine fruit, hand harvested, crushed and destemmed. Temp controlled alcoholic fermentation to 28 degrees celcius for 7 days with pumpovers and delistage for colour and tannin extraction followed by a short maceration. Pressed off skins using only free run wine followed by full malolactic fermentation. The wine is then cold stabilised and given a fine earth filtration prior to membrane filtration. This wine has been made as a bold modern expression of the Monastrell varietal. An average vine age of well over 30 years combined with the unique microclimate of small DO of Bullas has ensured great concentration of fruit from extremely small yields.

Careful temperature controlled fermentation and the collaboration of New World trained winemakers and local knowledge has produced a fruit driven wine typical of the Murcia region and Monastrell variety.

#### TASTING NOTE:

Wild raspberry and violet/earthy characteristics with complex notes of spice, leather and sweet American oak give way to a long, smooth vanilla finish.

**WINEMAKING NOTES:** Old concentrated bush vine fruit, hand harvested, crushed and destemmed. Temperature controlled alcoholic fermentation to 28 degrees celcius for 7 days with pumpovers and delistage for colour and tannin extraction followed by a short maceration. Pressed off skins using only free run wine followed by full malolactic fermentation. The wine is then cold stabilised and given a fine earth filtration prior to membrane filtration.

Arcillo – calcaire (chalk and clay soils) situated on the slopes of the Ribota valley of the Calatayud DO at an altitude of 700 – 900m above sea level. Free draining soils combined with minimal rainfall and significant differences in day and night time temperature gives rise to wines with excellent colour , aroma and distinctive varietal aromas.

This wine has been made as a bold, modern expression of the Tempranillo varietal. An average vine age of well over 30 years combined with the unique microclimate has ensured great concentration of fruit from extremely small yields (circa 35hl/ha).

Careful temperature controlled fermentation and the collaboration of New World trained winemakers and local knowledge has produced a fruit driven wine typical of the Calatayud area.

**CELLAR POTENTIAL:** Prefect for drinking now or for up to 5 years.

**TASTING NOTE:** Full bodied with fine, soft tannins and well balanced acidity. Soft raspberry and wild fruits give way to a long, smooth, spicy finish.

**FOOD RECOMMENDATIONS:** A great partner for tapas, hams and red meats.

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
